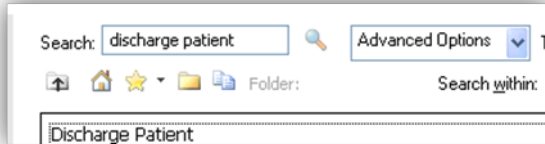
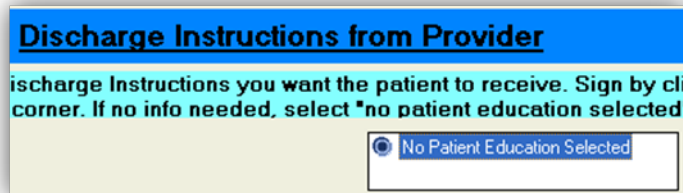

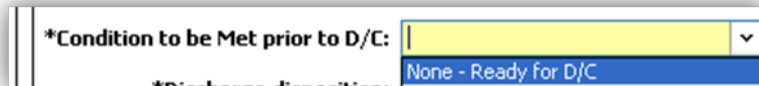
1. Enter a CPOE order called discharge Patient



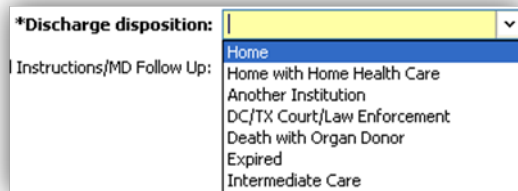
2. Complete the Patient Education Screen by selection No Patient Education Selected and sign:



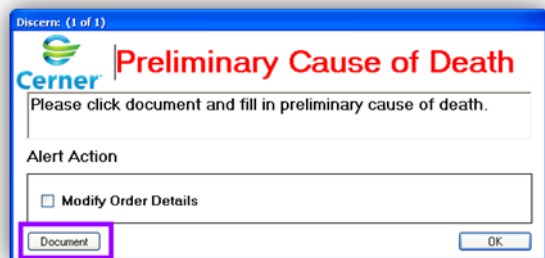
